<sup>1</sup>**CMU** – Undergraduate students enrolling prior to Fall 2008 are covered by The CMU Promise, a 5-year guaranteed tuition plan. Graduate students and undergraduate students enrolling Fall 2008 and beyond will have tuition rates set annually by the Board of Trustees.

<sup>2</sup>**EMU** – A General Education Program Fee of \$14.50/cr. hr. is assessed on each 100 level course in Mathematics, Communications, English, and Science. Program fees are assessed for 300-499 course level courses at the following rates: Foreign Language = \$42.75 per credit hour. Education (all), Health & Human Services (except Nursing, Fine Art (all)) = \$49.25/cr. hr. Science (Biol, Chem, Comp. Sci., Math, Phys. Astronomy), Business (all), and Technology = \$56.00/cr. hr. Nursing = \$71.00/cr. hr. All other courses (not covered above) = \$38.50/cr. hr. Doctoral Leadership/Counseling fees are \$82.40/cr. hr. Lab and studio fees range from \$0 - \$75 per course. Online course fees are \$46.50 per credit hour for all online courses. There is a Student Teaching fee of \$145.00 per class. Please note that beginning in fall 2009, the Fast Track Fee of \$29, the Record Initiation Fee of \$88, and the Orientation Fee of \$215 (a total of \$332) were combined into one New Student Fee for incoming Freshmen which is now \$300. New Student Fees for UG Transfers are \$150, and \$100 for incoming Post-Baccalaureate students.

<sup>3</sup>**LSSU** – An additional \$60/cr. is assessed for all engineering courses. An additional \$10/cr. is assessed for all chemistry courses. An additional \$25/cr. is assessed for all nursing and paramedic technology courses. An activity course fee of \$20 per credit is applied to one-credit courses in music and recreation.

<sup>4</sup>**MSU** – “Continuing” cohort rates originating prior to FS2005 and included since 2005-2006 were dropped from the 2010-11 calculations because few if any students in the cohort from prior to FS2005 remained enrolled. Regular resident undergraduate Summer rates for 2010-11 are used to calculate 2010-11 tuition for comparison purpose in Table 1.

<sup>5</sup>**MTU** – Engineering & Computer Science undergraduates taking fewer than 6 credits and graduate students taking fewer than 5 credits are assessed a program fee of \$352.50/semester. Engineering & Computer Science undergraduates taking 6 credits or more and graduate students taking 5 credits or more are assessed a program fee of \$705/semester. The Engineering/Computer Science program fee applies to all students in the College of Engineering - all majors except Applied Geophysics, Geology, and Geophysics and to all students in Computer Science in the College of Science and Arts. This fee does not apply to first-year students. The Graduate Resident and Non-Resident per credit rate for Applied Science Education and on-campus Peace Corps students is \$457/credit. The Graduate Resident and Non-Resident per credit rate for Graduate Students who are in the Research Only Mode is \$233.50/credit. The on-line MBA program is \$38,000 - this includes the cost of tuition for the two-year degree and three required residencies, which includes housing and most meals, but not transportation.

<sup>6</sup>**NMU** – An additional \$200/semester technology fee is assessed to all Art and Design majors, an additional \$75/semester program fee is assessed to all BSN and MSN Nursing students, Chemistry lab courses are assessed an additional \$40/course, Biology and Clinical Lab Sciences lab courses are assessed and additional \$25/course. Other program specific fees include \$82/course for bowling, \$35/course for golf, and \$4/course for cross country skiing.

<sup>7</sup>**OU** – Oakland University does not charge fees to its students; mandatory or non-mandatory.

<sup>8</sup>**SVSU** – An additional \$97.45/cr. is assessed for professional courses in Bs. & Management, Computer Information Systems, Computer Science, Education, Engineering, Kinesiology, Nursing, & Occupational Therapy.

<sup>9</sup>**UMAA** – This represents the LS&A undergraduate and general graduate rates. The following schools have different rates: Undergraduate: Business, Dentistry, Kinesiology, Music, Theatre & Dance, and Nursing Accelerated Second Career. Graduate: Architecture, Art & Design, Business, Dentistry, Education, Engineering, Kinesiology, Law, Medicine, Music, Theatre and Dance, Natural Resources & Environment, Nursing, Pharmacy, Public Health, Public Policy, Social Work. "Masters" rates are for masters and pre-candidate students. "PhD" rates are for candidates.

<sup>10</sup>**UM-D** – 300-499 level courses in CASL & Ed. are assessed an additional \$8.55 per cr. hr., 300-499 level courses in Engineering are assessed an additional \$52.60 per cr. hr., 300-499 level courses in Business are assessed an additional \$140.70 per cr. hr., 500 & above level courses in Engineering are assessed an additional \$85.00 per cr. hr., 500 & above level courses in Business are assessed an additional \$189.15 per cr. hr. All CASL, Ed., Business & Unclassified students: Electing six or less cr. hrs. are assessed \$55.70, electing seven or more cr. hrs. are assessed \$111.35, Engineering students: Electing six or less cr. hrs. is assessed \$87.70, electing seven or more cr. hrs. is assessed \$175.40.

<sup>11</sup>**UM-F** – Fee's applied to select groups: UL Bus courses add \$49 per credit. All Engineering, Computer Science, Computer Information Systems courses add \$15 per credit. All Online courses add \$43 per credit. All Nursing students program fee of \$65 per semester. Nursing @ 15 resident credits \$10,754/yr. Grad Physical Therapy (DPT) course fee \$35 per credit. DPT students full time is 12 credits, tuition & fees is \$11,708.
