An additional \$77/credit hour is assessed to all Master of Science in Nursing and Doctor of Nursing Practice program courses, and an additional \$10/semester is assessed to all Communication and Media Studies majors and Theatre and Dance majors. Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Astronomy, Geography/Environmental Science and 100-499 level courses in Technology and Occupational Sciences are assessed an additional \$30/credit hour. Emergency Health Care lab and Athletic Training lab (ATR 420/520, ATR 421/521 and ATR 550) courses are assessed an additional \$25/lab, other Athletic Training lab courses not previously listed and Engineering Tech lab courses are assessed an additional \$50/lab, Radiography clinics are assessed an additional \$50/course, and Art and Design Courses are assessed an additional \$9/credit hour. Other program specific fees include \$82/course for bowling and \$35/course for golf.

⁸**OU** – Oakland University does not charge fees to its students; mandatory or non-mandatory. Graduate students are assessed a \$45 application charge, effective Fall 2017. Undergraduate students also pay a per credit hour premium when taking upper division 300-499 level courses as follows: \$30/chhr for College of Arts, Sciences & Letters, The College of Education, Health and Human Services, \$150/chhr for the College of Business, \$125/chhr for the College of Engineering and Computer Science. Undergraduate students taking graduate classes in 4+1 degree programs also pay an additional \$200 per credit hour premium for 500+ level courses.
