¹**EMU** – A General Education Program Fee of \$15.00/cr. hr. is assessed on each 100 level course in Mathematics, Communications, English, and Science. Program fees are assessed for 300-499 course level courses at the following rates: Foreign Language = \$46.10 per credit hour. Education (all), Health & Human Services (except Nursing, Fine Art (all)) = \$53.10/cr. hr. Science (Biol, Chem, Comp. Sci., Math, Phys. Astronomy), Business (all), and Technology = \$60.40/cr. hr. Nursing = \$76.55/cr. hr. All other courses (not covered above) = \$41.50/cr. hr. for UG, \$70.70/cr.hr. for Grad, and \$88.85/cr.hr. for Doctoral. Doctoral Leadership/Counseling fees are \$88.85/cr. hr. and Physician's Assistant fees are \$83.00/cr.hr. Online course fees are \$50.00 per credit hour for all online courses. There is a Student Teaching fee of \$155.00 per class. Please note that beginning in fall 2009, the Fast Track Fee of \$29, the Record Initiation Fee of \$88, and the Orientation Fee of \$215 (a total of \$332) were combined into one New Student Fee for incoming Freshmen which is now \$300. New Student Fees for UG Transfers are \$150, and \$100 for incoming Post-Baccalaureate students.

²**FSU** - Starting Spring 2014 Ferris will have a differential tuition rate for Junior and Seniors. Undergraduate tuition rate for Junior and Senior students will increase for Spring 2014 as follows: Resident \$370.00 per credit hour, Non-Resident \$555.00 per credit hour, and International Students \$594 per credit hour.

³**GVSU** - An Additional \$20/cr. is assessed for all Cell & Molecular Biology course 200 level & above. An additional \$25/cr. is assessed for all School of Engineering and Nursing courses 200 level & above. An additional \$15/cr. is assessed for all 300 level & above courses in Art & Design, Music, and International Studies. An addition \$20/cr. is assessed for 300 level & above courses in School of Computing, Occupation Safety and Health, Radiologic & Image Science, Allied Health, Medical Lab Science, Speech and Language Pathology, and Therapeutic Recreation. An additional \$25/cr. is assessed for 300 level & above courses in Seidman College of Business.

⁴**LSSU** – An additional \$60/cr. is assessed for all engineering courses. An additional \$10/cr. is assessed for all chemistry courses. An additional \$40/cr. Is assessed for all nursing and paramedic technology courses. An activity course fee of \$20 per credit is applied to one-credit courses in music and recreation. Regional Center courses are charged an additional \$25/cr.

⁵**MTU** – Engineering & Computer Science undergraduates taking fewer than 6 credits and graduate students taking fewer than 5 credits are assessed a program fee of \$377.50/semester. Engineering & Computer Science undergraduates taking 6 credits or more and graduate students taking 5 credits or more are assessed a program fee of \$755.00/semester. The Engineering/Computer Science program fee applies to all students in the College of Engineering - all majors except Applied Geophysics, Geology, and Geophysics and to all students in Computer Science in the College of Science and Arts. This fee does not apply to first-year students. The Graduate Resident and Non-Resident per credit rate for Applied Science Education and on-campus Peace Corps students is \$514.00/credit. The Graduate Resident and Non-Resident per credit rate for Graduate Students who are in the Research Only Mode is \$263.00/credit. The on-line MBA program is \$41,000 - this includes the cost of tuition for the two-year degree and three required residencies, which includes housing and most meals, but not books or travel expenses.

⁶**NMU** – An additional \$250/semester technology fee is assessed to all Art and Design majors, an additional \$75/semester program fee is assessed to all BSN and MSN and LPN Nursing students, Chemistry lab courses are assessed an additional \$40/course, Biology and Clinical Lab Sciences lab courses are assessed and additional \$25/course. Other program specific fees include \$82/course for bowling, \$35/course for golf, and \$4/course for cross country skiing.
