For graduate students, an additional \$12/credit hour is assessed for most Physical Therapy courses.
- <sup>2</sup> EMU A General Education Program Fee of \$14.00 per credit hour is assessed on each 100 level course in Mathematics, Communications, English, and Science. All Military Science courses are assessed a \$10.70 per credit hour fee. Program fees are assessed for 300-499 course level courses at the following rates: Foreign Language = \$39.75 per credit hour. Education (all), Health & Human Services (except Nursing), Fine Art (all) = \$45.75 per credit hour. Science (Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Mathematics, Physics, Astronomy), Business (all), and Technology = \$52.00 per credit hour. Nursing = \$66.00 per credit hour.
