## ENROLLMENT REPORT

FALL 2002

### Summary

- Total headcount for Fall 2002 increased 1.73% over Fall 2001 (284,500 vs. 279,669) - **Table 1**
- Graduate student headcount increased by 6.5% over Fall 2001, based on preliminary 2002-03 numbers. - **Table 5**
- Fall 2002 first-time freshmen enrollment decreased 3.17% from Fall 2001, but remains 22.9% higher than fall 1992 - **Table 3**
- Total fiscal year equated students was a record 241,134 in 2001-02 - **Table 4**
