The Engineering/Computer Science program fee applies to all students in the College of Engineering - all majors except Applied Geophysics, Geology, and Geophysics and to all students in Computer Science in the College of Science and Arts. This fee does not apply to first-year students. The Graduate Resident and Non-Resident per credit rate for Applied Science Education and on-campus Peace Corps students is \$485.00/credit. The on-line MBA program is \$41,000 - this includes the cost of tuition for the two-year degree and three required residencies, which includes housing and most meals, but not books or travel expenses.
