An additional \$250/semester technology fee is assessed to all Art and Design majors, an additional \$39/credit hour is assessed to all 300-499 level courses in Business and Clinical Sciences, 200-499 level courses in Nursing and all courses in Music except Music in Society, and an additional \$50/credit hour is assessed to all Communication and Media Btudies majors. Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Astronomy, Geography/Environmental Science and 100-499 level courses in Technology and Occupational Sciences are assessed an additional \$24/credit hour. Emergency Health Care lab and Athletic Training lab (ATR 420/520, ATR 421/521 and ATR 550) courses are assessed an additional \$25/course, other Athletic Training lab courses not previously listed are assessed an additional \$50/course, Radiography clinics are assessed an additional \$50/course for golf.
