Effective Fall 2019 - undergraduate tuition is transitioning to Lower Level/Upper Level rate structure. All new and non-continuously enrolled returning students will fall under the new tuition structure. Those who entered under the previous tuition structure will remain as long as continuously enrolled. Various other fees may be assessed according to program concentration/coursework. This represents the general graduate and undergraduate rates.
