An additional \$47/credit hour is assessed to all 300-400 level courses in Clinical Lab Sciences and to all 200-400 level courses in Nursing. An additional \$77/credit hour is assessed to all Master of Science in Nursing and Doctor of Nursing Practice program courses, and an additional \$10/semester is assessed to all Communication and Media Studies majors and Theatre and Dance majors. Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Astronomy, Geography/Environmental Science and 100-499 level courses in Technology and Occupational Sciences are assessed an additional \$30/credit hour. Emergency Health Care lab and Athletic Training lab (ATR 420/520, ATR 421/521 and ATR 550) courses are assessed an additional \$25/lab, other Athletic Training lab courses not previously listed and Engineering Tech lab courses are assessed an additional \$50/course for golf.
